DEFENDANT'S RESPONSE TO MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION

Plaintiff states that the determination of whether three employees of the Ohio State Highway Patrol acted in a reckless manner "will affect Wrinn's state law claims, and the United States District Court for the Northern District has held that it will reinstate Wrinn's federal claims against the OSHP officers in federal court." Because plaintiff seeks to bring a §1983 claim against the officers in federal court, the court correctly noted that R.C. 2743.02(F) does not apply to federal claims. Defendant urges the court to overrule plaintiff's motion for reconsideration.


