While we do agree that "winter conditions" should be expected in Ohio, Hannah Scolaro was dressed appropriately for the winter conditions. What I disagree with is that the dining hall was closed for renovations - and the bus to transport students to the dining hall was located at the bottom of a cement walk. If students are expected to walk down a hilly cement walk to catch a bus, the walkway should be salted knowing that students would be using that route. The University scheduled the bus to pick up at that location. Other sidewalks were salted - so it did not appear that there was not salt available.
