

DEFENDANT'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Pursuant to Ohio Civil Rule 6(B), Defendant University of Cincinnati College of Medicine respectfully moves this Court for an order granting it a 60-day extension of time to answer or otherwise plead. The University requests this additional time because the parties have been working to settle this matter. While the parties are nearing agreement on potential settlement terms, they simply need more time to resolve this matter than the current answer date provides. This request is not made in an attempt to delay proceedings, but is made in good faith to try and resolve these matters. The University must currently file a responsive pleading to Plaintiff's complaint on April 28, 2016. With the 60-day extension, the University will file a responsive pleading on or before June 27, 2016 if the matter is not resolved through settlement before that time. Undersigned counsel has contacted counsel for Plaintiff, and Plaintiff's counsel has agreed to this extension of time.
