ENTRY ORDERING DISPOSAL OF
EXHIBITS AND DEPOSITIONS

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1) Pursuant to L.C.C.R. 11(F), parties who filed or offered evidence consisting of models, diagrams, depositions, photographs, x-rays, and other exhibits and materials and who wish to withdraw the same, must file a written request for such withdrawal prior to August 15, 2016;

- 4) On August 22, 2016, the clerk shall destroy or dispose of those exhibits and depositions whose withdrawal is not timely requested or which are not withdrawn in accordance with the above paragraphs.
