

ENTRY ORDERING DISPOSAL OF
EXHIBITS AND DEPOSITIONS

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1) Pursuant to L.C.C.R. 11(F), parties who filed or offered evidence consisting of models, diagrams, depositions, photographs, x-rays, and other exhibits and materials and who wish to withdraw the same, must file a written request for such withdrawal prior to March 6, 2017;
- 2) The request shall identify the items sought, specify how and when the items will be withdrawn and will be served upon all parties pursuant to Civil Rule 5;
- 3) Parties shall appear personally at the court and acknowledge receipt of the items or make arrangements satisfactory to the clerk for prepaid transportation of the same. (The court is not responsible for the cost of handling, mailing or transportation charges incident to the return of such items.);
- 4) On March 13, 2017, the clerk shall destroy or dispose of those exhibits and depositions whose withdrawal is not timely requested or which are not withdrawn in accordance with the above paragraphs.
